


12. Rates shall be quoted and, subsequent payments under this Contract shall be made in BD Taka currency. The price offered by the Quotationer, if accepted shall remain fixed for the duration of the Contract.
13. Quotationer shall have legal capacity to enter into Contract. Quotationer, in support of its qualification shall be required to submit certified photocopies of latest documents related to valid **Trade License, Tax Identification Number (TIN), VAT Registration Number and Financial Solvency Certificate** from any scheduled Bank; without which the Quotation may be considered non-responsive. **Furthermore KfW Eligibility Criteria shall be fulfilled.**
14. Quotationer shall provide a signed Declaration of Undertaking (form as provided below) with the bid. Failure to do so will result in a rejection of bid.
15. Quotations shall be evaluated based on information and documents submitted with the Quotations, by the Evaluation Committee and, at least three (3) responsive Quotations will be required to determine the lowest evaluated responsive Quotations for award of the Contract. Quotations will be evaluated based on a pass/fail evaluation scheme presented in the Technical Specifications. The Quotationer which is considered responsive, technically qualified and offered the lowest bid price will be award the contract.
16. In case of anomalies between unit rates or prices and the total amount quoted, the unit rates or prices shall prevail. In case of discrepancy between words and figures the former will govern. Quotationer shall remain bound to accept the arithmetic corrections made by the Evaluation Committee.
17. The supply of Goods and related services shall be completed within **60 days** from the date of issuing the Purchase Order.
18. The Purchase Order that constitutes the Contract binding upon the Supplier and the Procuring Entity shall be issued within **7 days** of receipt of approval from the Approving Authority.
19. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject all the Quotations or annul the procurement proceedings.
